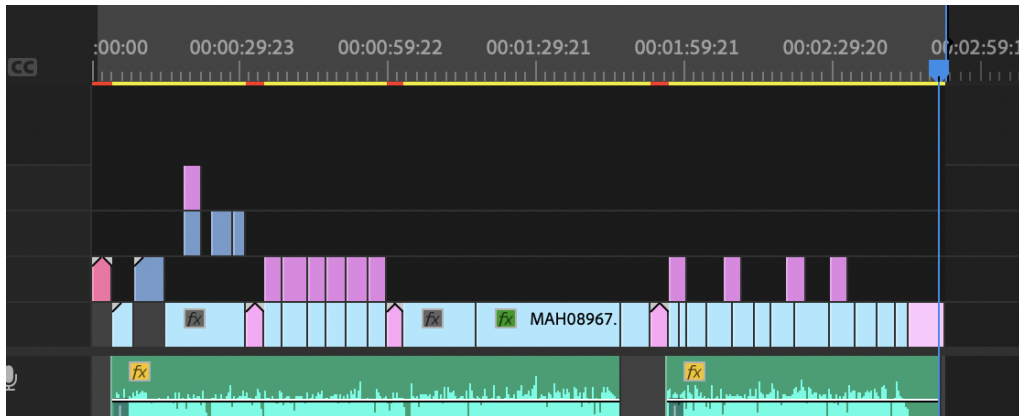


READY TO SUBMIT YOUR WORK?

Wait a minute! You may have missed something, so here is a checklist to keep handy before you go export your video file and submit your MP4 to canvas.

- Play through your project and double check for any missing frames, errors, audio flaws, etc.
- Last minute color correction and adjustments to any FX or graphics
- Did you set your Ins and Outs?

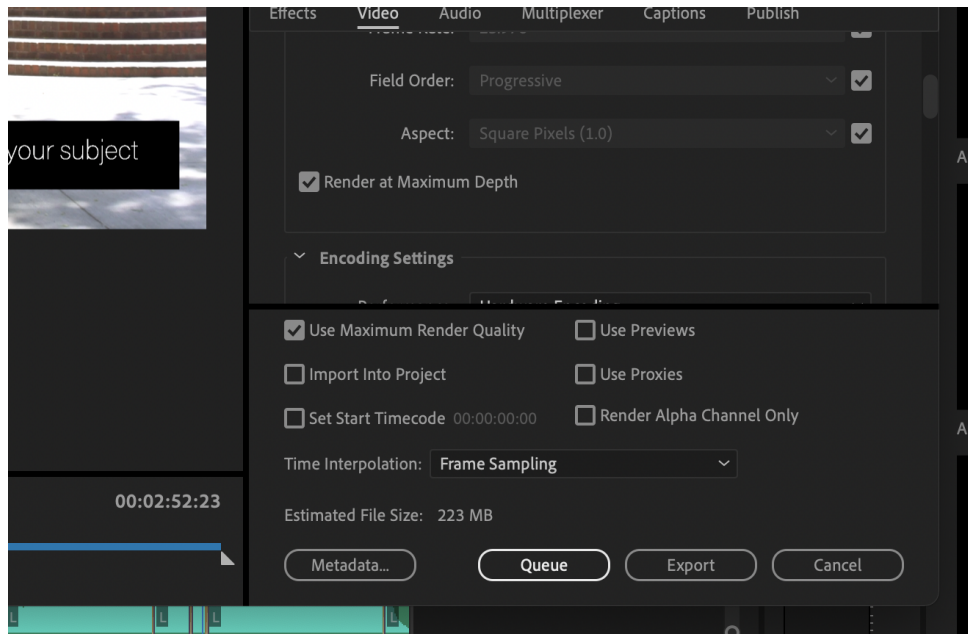
(The highlighted section is what it looks like when you have your In and Out point selected)



- If all the above is good to go, now you export.

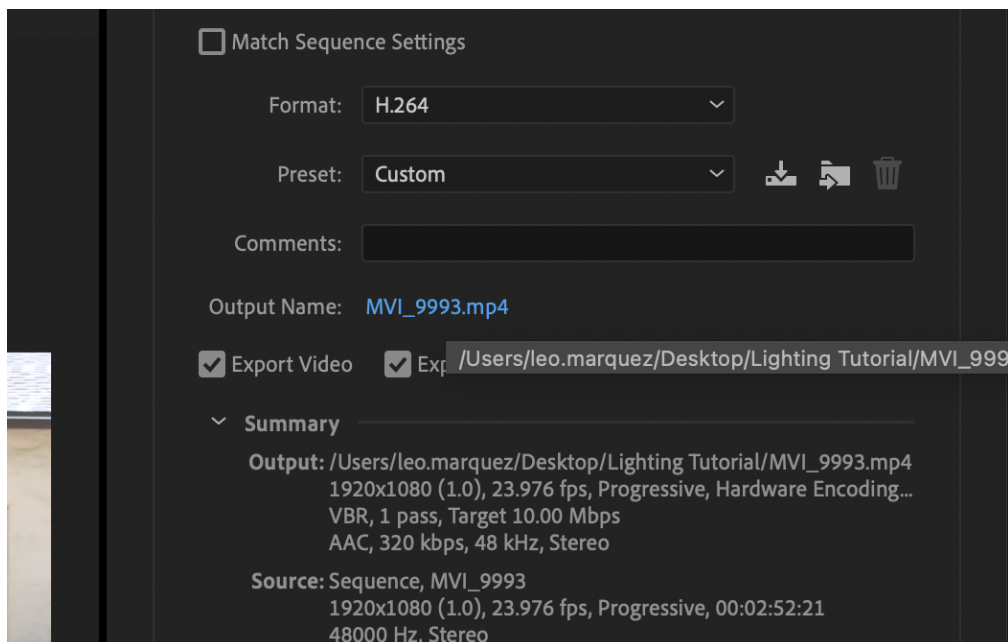
File > Export > Media

****Make sure that the following is checked when in Export Window****



- Render at Maximum Depth needs to be checked
- Use Maximum Render Quality needs to be checked

- Format must be H.264 (this makes it a MP4 video file)
- Where it says Output Name: MVI_993.mp4 in the image below this is where you need to click on the highlighted blue text and choose the proper folder of where this MP4 will export to.



- ❑ Once that is all done, you need to submit to Canvas.

- ❑ Go to designated assignment
 - ❑ Click Submit
 - ❑ Click Upload towards the bottom
 - ❑ Select the MP4 file you exported
 - ❑ Let the file upload until it says you have submitted it.
